VISUAL FAN SHARES WILL START TRADING ON AeRO MARKET ON MONDAY, JULY 26

Bucharest Stock Exchange (BVB) informs that on Monday, July 26th, Visual Fan shares, a Romanian technology company founded in Brasov in 2002 and which owns the Allview brand, will start trading on AeRO market, the equity segment of the Multilateral Trading System. The shares will be traded under the ticker ALW.

The private placement was carried on April 23rd. The company sold 111,100 shares at a price of RON 140 per share and managed to raise from the capital market investors RON 15.5mn. A total number of 161 investors subscribed during the private placement, out of which 32 were qualified investors and 129 retail investors. The anticipated capitalization of the company amounts to RON 155.5mn. The private placement and the listing were assisted by TradeVille.

Visual Fan team will ring BVB's bell for the company's listing on Monday, July 26th. The Opening Bell ceremony will be broadcasted LIVE, starting with 10:00 AM, on BVB's social media channels Facebook, YouTube and LinkedIn.
