In the background of recent events in Kazakhstan, the activities and operations of KMG International in Romania and the Black Sea region took place under normal conditions, the supply of crude oil being made in accordance with the processing schedule of the Petromidia Năvodari refinery. KMG International Group is entirely owned by the national oil and gas company KazMunayGas Kazakhstan.

Thus, the operational processes of the Petromidia Năvodari and Vega Ploiești refineries were not disrupted, the stocks of raw materials destined for processing being sufficient and at the levels forecasted by the specialists from Rompetrol Rafinare. At the moment, the daily crude oil processing is at an average level of 13.6 tons, even in a slight increase compared to the initial forecasts, and the production in the first days of the year amounts to about 60 thousand tons of raw materials materials, in line with production plans.

At the same time, the Group's trading division has taken additional measures to ensure and secure the supply of raw materials and petroleum products. Absolutely all business activities, on each operational line, whether we are talking about the trading, refining and downstream division, operate at the normal parameters, provided in the previously approved business plans.

Last but not least, no Romanian citizen, employee of any company belonging to the Group, is currently in Kazakhstan, whether we are talking about the headquarters of the parent company in Nur-Sultan, or at the refineries operated by KazMunayGas.

We reiterate that the KMG International Group remains a stable partner and a strategic investor for Romania, through its activities throughout the country, but also in the region.
