Ploiești, September 17, 2026 - AQUILA (BVB: [AQ](#)), one of the largest distributors of fast-moving consumer goods in Romania and the region, will be included in the FTSE Global All Cap indices starting September 21st, 2026, nearly five years after the company was listed on the Bucharest Stock Exchange. The shares of the company are also included in the MSCI Frontier IMI and MSCI Romania IMI indices.

Jean Dumitrescu, Investor Relations Director, AQUILA:

“When we decided to list AQUILA on the Bucharest Stock Exchange in 2021, we saw the capital market as a tool to accelerate the company's growth. We raised EUR 74 million, the largest IPO at the time by a Romanian entrepreneurial company, to continue investing, pursuing acquisitions and expanding regionally. Five years later, AQUILA's market capitalization has increased from approximately RON 1.1 billion to more than RON 2.4 billion. During this period, we have consistently focused on increasing liquidity and diversifying our investor base, while proactively engaging with the investors. Inclusion in the FTSE Global All Cap marks a new milestone in this journey and increases AQUILA's visibility among international investors. Our objective remains AQUILA's long-term development and creating value for our shareholders.”

In March 2022, AQUILA shares were included in the BET, the benchmark index of the Bucharest Stock Exchange, and in June of the same year, they entered the FTSE Russell indices for the first time through their inclusion in the FTSE Global Micro Cap. Following the September review, AQUILA joins the Romanian companies already included in the FTSE Global All Cap, bringing the total number of local issuers included in the index to ten.

The FTSE Global All Cap is part of FTSE Russell's global index series and includes large, mid and small-cap companies from developed and emerging markets. AQUILA's inclusion in the FTSE Global All Cap reflects the company's progress against the market capitalization and liquidity criteria considered by FTSE Russell, the global index provider, and increases its visibility among international institutional investors that track these indices.

About AQUILA

AQUILA is one of the largest distributors of fast-moving consumer goods in Romania and the region. The company markets and develops brands across modern retail, traditional trade, HoReCa and other specialized channels through an integrated sales, trade marketing, execution and logistics platform.

AQUILA operates in Romania, the Republic of Moldova and Hungary, with a portfolio of over 22,000 products and a network covering more than 78,000 points of sale. The company's infrastructure includes logistics and transportation capabilities for ambient, chilled and frozen products, supported by a fleet of more than 1,600 vehicles.

In 2025, AQUILA's revenue reached a record high of approximately RON 3.5 billion, up 18% compared to the previous year, supported by the strengthening of the distribution segment, portfolio diversification and the development of its own brands.

Founded in 1994 and listed on the Bucharest Stock Exchange in November 2021 under the ticker symbol AQ, AQUILA is included in the Bucharest Stock Exchange's benchmark BET index, as well as in the MSCI Frontier and MSCI Romania indices, and on September 21, 2026, it will be included in FTSE Global All Cap indices.

The company achieved the maximum VEKTOR by ARIR score of 10, which assesses listed companies' investor communication, and was awarded the EcoVadis Silver Medal in 2025 for its sustainability performance.

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
