(the “**Fund**” or “**Fondul Proprietatea**”) have met during the Shareholders' Extraordinary General Meeting (“**EGM**”) of the Fund, at the first convening, at “**JW MARRIOTT BUCHAREST GRAND HOTEL**”, **Constanța Ballroom, 13 Septembrie Avenue no. 90, 5th District, Bucharest, 050726, Romania**, the EGM being opened by its Chairman, namely Mr. Daniel Naftali, in his capacity of permanent representative of Franklin Templeton International Services S.À R.L., a *société à responsabilité limitée* qualifying as an alternative investment fund manager under article 5 of the Luxembourg Law of 12 July 2013 on alternative investment fund managers, authorized by the *Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier* under no. there are met the quorum for holding this meeting and the majority for shareholders to decide legally, under the legally required majority (according to art. 115 paragraphs (1)-(2) of the Companies’ Law no. 31/1990 and art. 14 I paragraphs (5) (i) and (6) of the Fund’s Constitutive Act).

Following debates, the Fund’s shareholders decide as follows:

- I. The approval of the decrease of the subscribed and paid-up share capital of the Company by RON 131,090,615.24, from RON 1,664,407,948.32 to RON 1,533,317,333.08, pursuant to the cancellation of 252,097,337 own shares acquired by the Company during 2025 through the 16th buy-back programme.

Once the share capital decrease is finalized, the subscribed and paid-up share capital of Fondul Proprietatea shall have a value of RON 1,533,317,333.08, divided into 2,948,687,179 shares, each having a nominal value of RON 0.52 per share.

The first paragraph of Article 7 of the Constitutive Act after the share capital decrease is finalized will be changed as follows:

“(1) The subscribed and paid-up share capital of Fondul Proprietatea is in the amount of RON 1,533,317,333.08, divided into 2,948,687,179 ordinary nominative shares, having a nominal value of RON 0.52 each”.

The subscribed and paid-up share capital decrease will take place on the basis of Article 207 paragraph (1) letter c) of Companies’ Law no. 31/1990 and will be effective after all the following conditions are met:

- (i) this resolution is published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part IV for at least two months;
- (ii) the Financial Supervisory Authority authorizes the amendment of Article 7 paragraph (1) of the Constitutive Act of Fondul Proprietatea as approved by shareholders during this meeting, where required by applicable law or regulation;
- (iii) the shareholders' resolution approving this share capital decrease is registered with the Trade Registry.

This item is approved with **1,287,164,696** votes, representing **99.6947%** of the total votes held by the present or represented shareholders, in accordance with Article 14 I (6) of the Constitutive Act corroborated with Article 115 (2), second paragraph of Companies' Law no. 31/1990.
